








Linguistic Model of application in the field of Education in *ALSACE-MOSELLE*¹

-  Name of the language: Alsatian and Platt
-  Territory of application: Alsace (Alsatian) and Moselle (Platt)
-  Status of the language: Non official
-  Classification of the language according to the UNESCO: vulnerable
-  Not protected under the Charter for Regional or Minority Languages

General description of the linguistic model of application in the territory

French monolingual education is the standard.

Alsatian is taught in 10 schools in Alsace whereas Platt is taught in 2 schools in Moselle, all of them primary schools. The school-time in both languages goes from 10% to 50%.

-  Total number of **primary students** (basic education) enrolled in public and private institutions (schooling year 2018/2019) in both territories (Alsace and Moselle): **276.955**, of which **2.500** students in both territories study Alsatian/Platt as a subject in the school.
-  Total number of **secondary students** (middle school) enrolled in public and private institutions (schooling year 2018/2019) in both territories (Alsace and Moselle): **216.475** (Alsatian and Platt language are not taught in the secondary schools).
